MEET RULES

The following rules have been implemented to govern the Kansas MileSplit Middle School State Cross Country Championships on **Sunday, October 27, 2024**.

A. INDIVIDUAL PARTICIPATION

Any individual who is in 6th, 7th or 8th grade in the state of Kansas is eligible to participate.

B. TEAM PARTICIPATION

Teams may be comprised of any individual in the 6th & 7th or 8th grades from the state of Kansas. Those runners in 6th & 7th grade will run together. Athletes are encouraged to get school teammates &/or league competitors to participate and join your team.

C. TEAM SCORING

- 1. Teams may consist of 5-7 members comprised of individual boys/girls in the 6th & 7th or 8th grades.
- 2. The finishing position of an athlete shall be his/her score.
- 3. The total of the positions of the first five (5) members of each team shall be that team's score.
- 4. Displaced runners, those athletes who did not compete on a team, will be deleted from the list of place finishers. The team finishers will then be reassigned finishing places and the score calculated as indicated.
- 5. Teams with fewer than five (5) finishers shall not be scored as a team.
- 6. The team whose sixth member finishes first shall be given the higher place in case of a tie.

D. UNIFORMS

Competitors must wear clothing that is clean, designed and worn so as not to be objectionable. The competitors must not wear clothing that could impede the view of the judges. Athlete's tops must be of the same color on the front and back. All participating team members must wear jerseys (tops) of the same color. A team may wear shorts of any length but they must be of the same color.

NOTE: This meet is sanctioned by YES-Athletics. Athletes are not allowed to wear school issued uniforms. Please contact the meet director for possible team uniform options.

MFFT INFORMATION

AWARDS - Individual awards will be given to the top 20 individuals in each race in the finish chute. **First place team members** will be treated to a Baskin Robbins yogurt cone by the meet director.

REGISTRATION - Individual and team registration will start on Monday, October 1st. Registration will close at 8:00pm on Friday, October 25th. Please use this link for both team and individual registrations. Contact the meet director with any questions.

COST - \$20 per individual payable the day of the meet at the check-in table.

CHECK-IN - Check-in starts at 12:30pm and will remain open until 30 minutes before the last race. **COURSE WALK** - The course will be well marked and open to competitors starting at 12:30pm. You may walk the course prior to your race but you may not interfere with any ongoing race. Athletes should arrive at least 90 minutes prior to their race. **The course walks for the 4:45pm and 5:05pm open races will start at 4:05pm in the starting line area.**

TIMING - Provided by Black Squirrel Timing **OFFICIAL RESULTS** - Will be posted online after the meet.

RACE SCHEDULE

2:30pm - 6th & 7th Grade Girls with 11-12 Girls (born 2012-2013) open youth race participants (2 mile).

3:00pm - 6th & 7th Grade Boys with 11-12 Boys (born 2012-2013) open youth race participants (2 mile).

3:30pm - 8th Grade Girls with 13-14 Girls (born 2010-2011) open youth race participants (2 mile).

4:00pm - 8th Grade Boys with 13-14 Boys (born 2010-2011) open youth race participants (2 mile).

4:45pm - Open race for youth ages 6-8 born 2016-2018 (2K).

5:05pm - Open races for youth ages 9-10 born 2014-2015 (2 mile).

Registration for the open races will take place at the meet. Cost is \$10 and awards to all participants.

No spectators will be allowed in the starting line area before your race starts or the finish line area at any time.

AWARDS SCHEDULE - Individual awards will be handed out in the finish chute.
